As a Special Education Technician, your responsibilities will be:

- Maintain a supportive relationship with students in order to help defuse crisis situations, promote a return to calm and suggest solutions for behavior modification;
- Participate in the development and drafting of the intervention plan; select measures to be taken to achieve the objectives set out therein, evaluate the achievement of objectives and participate in the evaluation of the plan;
- Develop, organize and lead educational or pedagogical support activities (e.g. work organization) aimed at developing social, cognitive, psychomotor, communication or other skills;
- Plan and implement universal training (workshops on various themes such as bullying, stress management, conflict management, school motivation, school attendance);
- Apply special education techniques and methods, either as part of an intervention plan or as part of a program for students requiring special support;
- Be actively involved in the implementation of the fight plan and code of conduct;
- Meet with students under his/her responsibility, parents and teaching staff to advise and inform them, and provide them with relevant documentation and references;
- Collaborate with the school team in the deployment of a safe and healthy living environment.
